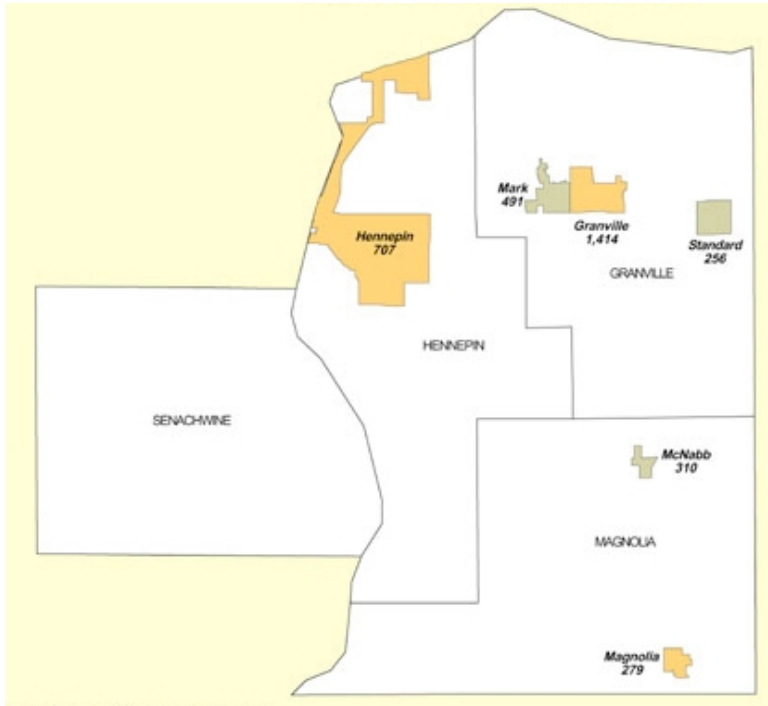


Putnam County, IL



Putnam is the smallest county in Illinois. Granville and Hennepin each have part-time police departments, all other police protection is handled by the Putnam County Sheriff's Office. PCSO also handles calls in Hennepin and Granville when the local PD's are unavailable. All Police and Fire dispatch is handled by the PCSO Communications Center. All township road work is done by the County Highway Department

Railroads:

Iowa Interstate runs the former Rock Island Peoria Line from Bureau Junction thru Putnam on the west side of the river. This uses 161.2200 for Road operations and 160.305 for switching.

Norfolk Southern runs the former Conrail (NYC) line from Kankakee thru McNabb that serves the mill at Hennepin. Operations are on 160.8000.
